White Wine

- 1 **Sauvignon Blanc Coopers Creek 2010** £13.00
Marlborough, New Zealand

This is absolutely classic Marlborough Sauvignon: vibrant gooseberry, passion fruit and nectarine backed with hints of herbaceousness. Impressive weight of flavour on the palate with richness and texture and a long finish.
- 2 **Chardonnay Chateau Ste. Michelle 2009** £13.50
Columbia Valley, Washington State, United States

A fresh, soft Chardonnay with bright, sweet citrus fruit character and subtle spice and oak nuances. Complex and interesting with the sur lie ageing adding an appealing softness.
- 3 **Touraine Sauvignon, Domaine du Haut Perron 2010** £11.00
Other, Loire, France

A fresh, grassy nose is followed by a palate full of green apple and citrus fruit, and even a touch of blackcurrant bud. Dry yet generous, with a long, crisp finish.

Rosé Wine

- 4 **Norton Malbec Rosé 2011** £10.00
Norton, Mendoza, Argentina

Red Wine

- 5 **Sauvignon Blanc Coopers Creek 2010** £12.00
Marlborough, New Zealand

A black fruited wine with a smooth palate and mouth-filling flavours.
- 6 **Barbera d'Asti Fiulot 2010** £13.00
Alfredo Prunotto, Piedmont, Italy

Fragrant on the nose with hints of plum and cherry. On the palate it is well structured and soft, showing the typical red fruit and bright character of the Barbera variety.
- 7 **Château de Terrefort-Lescalle 2009** £11.00
Bordeaux, France

A medium-bodied, approachable claret with juicy berry fruit backed up by savoury tobacco notes. Classically proportioned and elegantly balanced.

Sparkling Wine

- 8 **Jansz Premium Cuvée** £19.95
Tasmania, Australia
58% Chardonnay, 40% Pinot Noir, 2% Pinot Meunier

The bouquet shows lifted aromas of honeysuckle and citrus fruits from the Chardonnay, with nougat and roasted nuts derived from the tirage age, while the Pinot Noir contributes delicate strawberry. The palate is well-balanced with delicate fruit flavours.
